- 3. Vladek and Mala had a very different relationship from Vladek and Anja. Why did Vladek remarry? What was Anja and Vladek's relationship like throughout the war?
- 4. Why did Vladek's father not want him to serve in the military?
- 5. Why do you believe Vladek destroyed Anja's diaries, letters, and photographs? Why is Art so angry that these were destroyed?
- 6. How did Vladek's Holocaust experiences contribute to the kind of person he became?
- 7. On page 60 he saw the future? What do you think about that? Did it actually happen?
- 8. What role does wealth play throughout the book?
- 9. What did you think of little Richieu's death? How has his death impacted Art, Vladek, and Anja?
- 10. How did the idea of family change throughout the book?
- 11. Why did Artie call his dad a murder?
